

The Global Council of Nations is an international leadership network of advisors and activists who are committed to maximizing the freedom and prosperity of the citizens of the nations wherein we are serving. Using the principle-based concepts of the ancient scriptures as a starting point, we approach sound public policy as having the empowerment of people at its core.

We see the world trapped in sets of ideas that are frequently based on the maximization of power for the elites and those managing the world's resources. We likewise see many political parties operating out of expediency rather than clear principle-based concepts. We are committed to values and principles that are neither socialist nor hardline capitalist, and we recognize the need for policy that spiritually enhances both social community and the power of free, economic choice.

We believe that the ekklesia is designed by God to be the primary equipping center for believers as they are trained to effectively release God's truth in every sphere of society. We recognize that training must likewise be connected to the advisors and trainers of the five-fold ministries of Christ specifically enumerated by Apostle Paul in Ephesians 4:8-16 as directed by the Holy Spirit. We further believe that discipling nations (Matthew 28:19) requires a degree of expertise in the knowledge of how social systems actually work in the management of nations and how to move them toward alignment with God's patterns of Kingdom-based justice and righteousness. We also see the current church's shortcomings in advancing some of these responsibilities.

Our Global Council has three specific goals and benefits:

- 1) To provide a trust-based platform of private dialogue for members actually engaged in the process of discipling nations and serving their leaders.
- 2) To work together on developing best-practices knowledge and applications of concepts and structures that produce desired results.
- 3) To share resources and instructors where cooperating members believe they would further our common mission. We believe this cooperation would serve to break down the proprietary patterns of Christian work so common in a competitively based view of ministry which erroneously believes that we are all operating in a field of scarcity of both opportunity and resource.






MAJOR SPIRITUAL CONCEPTS

1. The need for principle-based public policy (measured by Master Principles).
2. The "Greatest Commandment" speaks to the individual and community.
3. All biblical policy is love-based.
4. Discipling nations works in this order: salvation → worldview → transforming culture and God-ordained institutions.
5. Discipling nations requires sustainable-based decision making.
6. Policy-making requires both reason-based and revelation-based thinking.
7. Policy-making requires the extrapolation of Old Testament Law into New Testament principles.
8. God requires all mankind to respond to scriptural truth (Matthew 4:4).
9. We disciple nations when we teach others biblical worldview.
10. Discipling a nation involves shaping cultural worldview and catechizing culture.
11. Discipling a nation involves the wise use of language strategy.
12. Discipling a nation involves teaching our children the power of basic skill-sets.
13. Discipling a nation involves teaching our children the reality of sowing and reaping.
14. Discipling a nation involves the teaching of the internalization of values and principles.
15. Discipling a nation involves teaching on the "tipping points" of culture.
16. Discipling a nation involves teaching on the reality of deploying social triage.
17. Discipling a nation involves teaching on tending our gardens (spheres of influence).
18. Discipling a nation involves teaching on living life on the offense (strategic living).
19. Discipling a nation involves teaching on the nature and power of the ecclesia.
20. Discipling a nation involves teaching on the strategic use of cultural "back fires."
21. Truth can be tested by its applicability to every generation, jurisdiction, and ethnic group.
22. Truth involves the objective-subjective debate.
23. Choice is the power behind incentives and energy growth.
24. Nations are eternal social institutions.
25. Spiritual skill-sets pass through death.
26. Service-based power creates "moral capital."
27. Freedom is the ability to obey God.
28. Love runs on rails.
29. Christians hold dual citizenship (nations, Kingdom).
30. Christians must function as "Kings" (leadership) and "priests" (peace-makers).





OVERVIEW OF SERVICES




THE INTERNATIONAL ALLIANCE OF COMMUNITY ACTION COUNCILS

COMMUNITY ACTION COUNCILS FOUNDATIONAL CONCEPTS
1. We are serving as citizens who happen to be Christians, not Christians who happen to be citizens.
2. A C.A.C. is not a church: we are working with whoever we can cooperate with to bring historic scriptural values to our community.
3. We speak secular language that is commonly understood.
4. The Scriptures addressed God’s creation of self-government, family government, church government, and civil government more than 3,400 years ago.
5. A Community Action Council is called to serve, influence and educate civil government and has no desire to replace the institution.
6. Effective community problem-solving and the discipling of nations, requires a clear analysis of the responsibilities and rights of individuals, families, churches, the business community and civil government, as we equip the people and leaders who influence all the spheres of society.
7. While all communities have both common and unique characteristics, the callings and projects we encourage C.A.C.s to engage should be as reproducible as is possible so as to utilize them broadly in multiple cities and nations.
