Worldview: The Antidote to Our Cultural Crisis

And I will make mere lads their princes, and capricious children will rule over them, and the people will be oppressed, each one by another, and each one by his neighbor; the youth will storm against the elder and the inferior against the honorable.—Isaiah 3:4-5

I. We are currently in a global crisis never seen before.

A. The crisis is spiritual, psychological, and socio-economic.

B. The people will need new leaders and a foundational re-grounding.

II. We must widely inject a new rediscovery of truth into the nations (applied worldview)
A. God's agenda for His people is critical as an antidote (cultural protection).
B. Skilled defense must proceed our offenses (blocking, countering).

Understanding Jurisdictions

- I. JURISDICTION God decentralizes government in self, family, business, church, and state.
 - A. The principle identified in the Garden of Eden
 - B. JURISDICTION: Latin jurisdictio; jus, juris, law, and dictio (to pronounce). "The legal power of authority of doing justice in cases of complaint; the power of executing the laws and distributing justice...
 - C. Christ Himself embodies justice
- II. The precepts of Scripture regarding jurisdiction
 - A. In church and state: Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. (Matthew 22:21; Romans 12-13; etc.)

	B. Personally in the Church (2 Timothy 3:5:) - having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

Truth & Transformation

- I. "God wants all men to be saved and go to heaven come to a *knowledge of the truth.*" (1 Timothy 2:4)
 - A. Did the West become PostTruth because the Church ceased being "the pillar and the foundation of the truth?" (1 Timothy 3:15)
- II. "God wants to baptize His servants with...
 ...the Spirit of irrationality wisdom and of under-standing,

...the Spirit of counsel and of might,

...the Spirit of the *knowledge* and *fear of the Lord.*" (Isaiah 11:2)

A. Did the Lord Jesus brand God's Spirit as the Spirit of Holiness and Power or *Truth*? (John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13)

III. Satan's mission is to take souls to hell deceive the nations.
A. Did Jesus commission the Church to save individual souls or to disciple nations?
IV. Nations are destroyed because of SIN or "lack of knowledge and understanding." (Isaiah 1:3; 5:13; 6:9-10. Jeremiah 2:8; 4:22; 5:4-5; 5:21; 8:7-8; 10:7-8, 14; Hosea 4:6, 14; Romans 1:18-21, 24, 28-32)
A. Did Paul assert his apostleship because he was a preacher and a healer or because he was a preacher and a teacher of the truth to gentiles? (1 Timothy 2:7; Titus 1:1)
V. A person is Born-Again when he prays the sinner's prayer and is baptized or when the law of God is inscribed in his heart. (Ezekiel 11:19; 36:26-27; Jeremiah 24:7; 31:33-34; 2 Corinthians 3:3)

The Ten Commandments: The Transcendental Source of a Culture of Goodness, Beauty, and Truth

- I. "Postmodernism" is Secular Humanism's confession that (without divine revelation) Philosophy cannot know Goodness, Beauty and Truth (even though the conscience knows them.)
- II. Two Hollywood films by Oliver Stone, (i) *Wall Street* (1987) and (ii) *Wall Street: Money Never Sleeps* (2010), featuring Michael Douglas as Gordon Gekko, capture the destructive economic consequences of philosophy's failure.
- III. The Ten Commandments are the transcendental source of our knowledge of goodness, beauty, and truth. As C. S. Lewis pointed out, Truth reflects God's mind, Goodness His character, Beauty His glory.
- IV. In Wall Street (1987), Gordon Gekko argued, "Greed is good"—a dictum that came from atheist, capitalist philosopher/scriptwriter, Ayn Rand, and Nobel laureate Economist, Milton Friedman. In the Wall Street crash of 2007-08, responsible world leaders began to realize the desperate need to return to sanity . . . and that was the theme of Oliver Stone's Wall Street II.

- V. God's Moral Law, the Ten Commandments, is the divine recipe for transforming nations into Great Nations (Genesis 18:18-19; Deuteronomy 4:5-8; 5:32-33).
- VI. The Tenth Commandment, "You shall not covet," is an excellent summary of the biblical idea that the spirit must rule over the flesh and deceptive "self-interest."
 - A. The 10th commandments calls us simultaneously to be content and creative.
 - B. To be content is to be grateful—which requires one to know the sovereign God and rest in His goodness and care.
 - C. The Commandment calls us to seek, know, and believe the truth
 - D. To be creative like the Creator and work to produce abundance
 - E. To love our neighbors enough to partner with them in establishing our dominion over the earth
 - F. To build families that respect socio-economic political authority structures
 - G. To be trustworthy enough to produce the fruit of liberty

VII. Without the Ten Commandments, the West will lose its prosperity and its liberty.


