The Crossroads of Culture

This is what the LORD says: “Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it, and you will find rest for your souls. But you said, ‘We will not walk in it.’” —Jeremiah 6:16

We are standing at a crossroads as a culture. Our current methods have not produced the life they promised. But God has provided another way. The crossroads offer us a fresh opportunity to find and follow Jesus’ way.

- The way we choose to walk is based on the destination we want to reach.
- The way we choose to walk forms us and, thus, creates a progression of implications with each step forward.
- Transformation requires choosing another way to walk.
- The crossroads are descriptive of a moment of opportunity where a new way can be taken.
- When at the crossroads, we must STAND, LOOK, ASK, and then WALK.

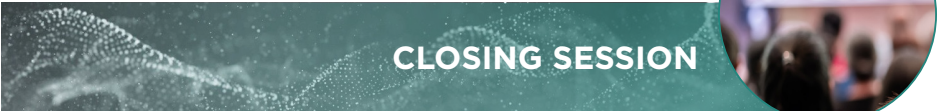
