SESSION 1: THE ANTIDOTE FOR SECULARISM AND RELIGIOUS DUALISM by Katherine Gallagher

As a global church, we have subtly and substantially absorbed far more from the society around us than we realize. While culture may be in conflict, truth is not. Theology matters. Discipleship in the local church is critical; understanding the gridwork of worldview is pivotal.

SESSION 2: THE ROLE OF THE ECCLESIA IN THE COMMUNITY by Dennis Peacocke

The body of Christ is called to function as an ecclesia (which literally means “those called out to rule”) and serves a vital jurisdictional role in the broader culture. How can we build across time within our communities as the church we are called to be? The word “church” has been emptied of its true biblical meaning as Christ’s governing body—a connected body, not just solo parts—and believers must recover and practice its true, godly design and purposes.

- ROLE & BOUNDARIES OF THE ECCLESIA: Government, impact, and influence
- ECCLESIA “HOW TO”: Community action and equipped service should be the natural fruit of a truly Kingdom church.

1. What has been your understanding of the ecclesia, and how can you better share that with those you lead and influence?
2. What might you have to say “no” to in order to say “yes” to discipleship and the ecclesia?
