#### In the Vineyard

## Together, the environment and human influence create the unique flavor of each wine.

Terroir (te-rwa:r) is a French word which describes the interactive ecosystem of soil, topography, and climate. Terroir imparts a flavor profile to wine, each one unique according to the particular place where the grapes were grown. Human influence sometimes controls and often mitigates the effects of the environment to showcase the sense of place, or the terroir, for each bottle of wine.

Soil - The diverse combination of organic and inorganic matter that sustains the vines.

Topography - Geographic features, such as hills and valleys, where vines are planted.

Climate - The general aspects of sun, rain, and fog that influence the vines.

Human Influence - The decisions made by the winegrower for the vines and the wine.

#### As a Metaphor
