Dr. Benjamin Levi Moses is the Executive Director of Global Leadership Geneva-Bern Switzerland, and President of the Global Institute for Leaders Excellence and Nation Building. He serves ambassadors from 193 nations at the United Nations in Geneva Switzerland, as well as parliamentarians, senior policymakers, and business leaders. His work focuses on ethical, moral, and spiritual leadership, peace building, public service, and nation building, helping leaders translate biblical values into concrete policies and practical frameworks that can be applied within national and international contexts. His approach is values based, human centered, and rooted in a Christian worldview that upholds human dignity, justice, responsibility, and the common good. He also serves as Senior Pastor of the International Evangelical Church of Lausanne, leading an international Christian community at the intersection of faith, leadership, and public life. Together with his wife, Dr. Jessy Benjamin, he founded the Foundation for Indian Children's Future, which advances education, leadership development, and longterm opportunity for underprivileged children in India. His work intentionally bridges faith, governance, and global responsibility in service of nations and future generations.
